BUDDY BAGS

When children go into foster care they are removed from a home that has been deemed a risk. They often leave the home with no belongings. A blanket or stuffed animal can provide comfort for a child going to



stuffed animal can provide comfort for a child going to an unfamiliar home. It is something they can call their own.

These children also often do not have the basic necessities such as a toothbrush, comb or basic hygiene items. Babies often have few or no diapers.

A buddy Bag can help assist a child transition to a sometimes unfamiliar living arrangement.
