#### (Stand)

Pastor: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. People: Amen.

Pastor: On this All Saints Sunday, we are mindful of the overflowing grace of God, our heavenly Father. He sent His only-begotten Son to become one of us to die for us. In accepting Christ's all-availing sacrifice on the cross, God has declared us to be His holy saints, His totally forgiven sons and daughters. 

Revelation 7:9-17

<sup>9</sup>After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, <sup>10</sup> and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" <sup>11</sup> And all the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, <sup>12</sup> saying, "Amen! 


#### THE EPISTLE


#### **POST COMMUNION CANTICLE – Nunc Dimittis**
